## Providing an Exceptional Publishing Experience

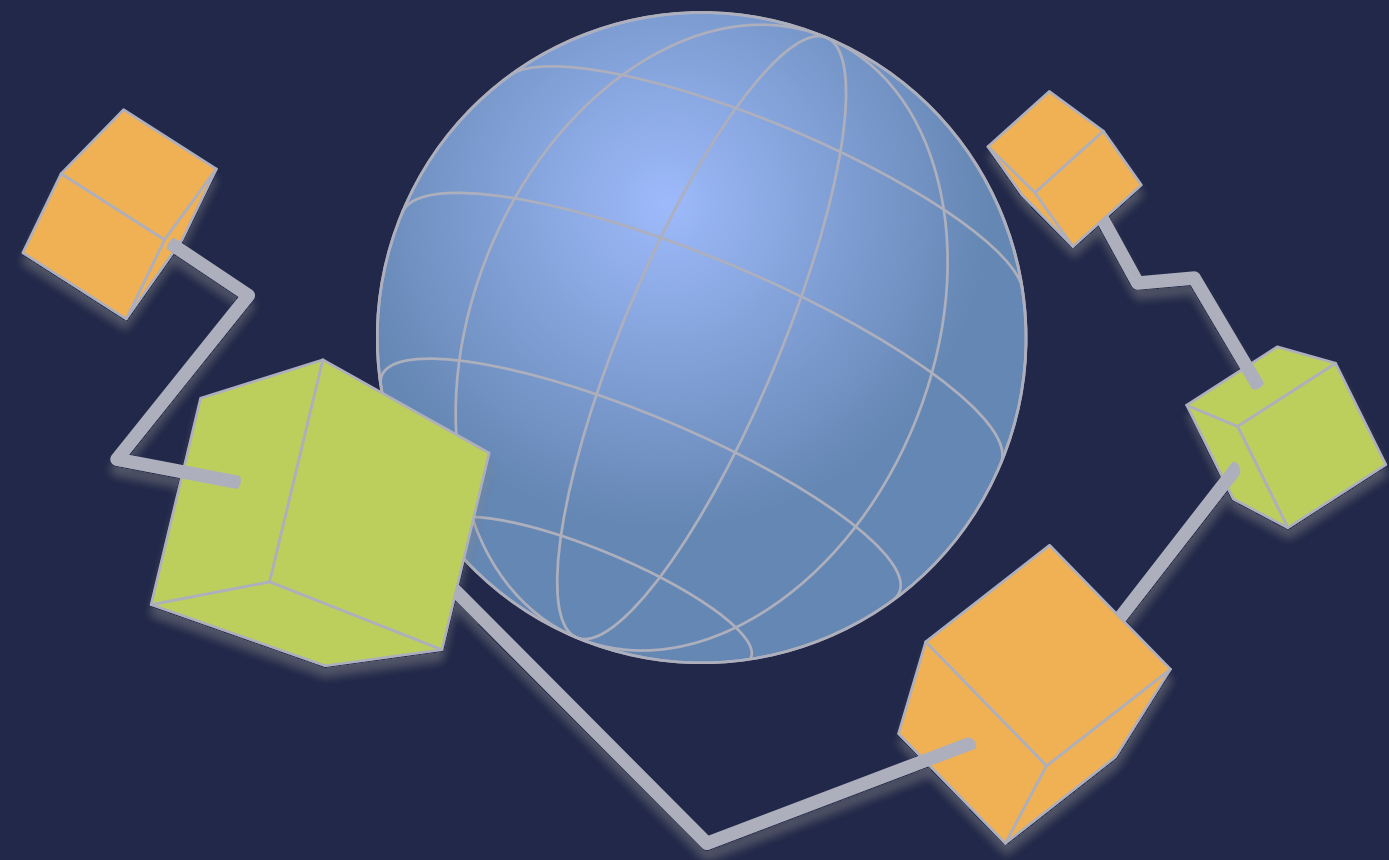

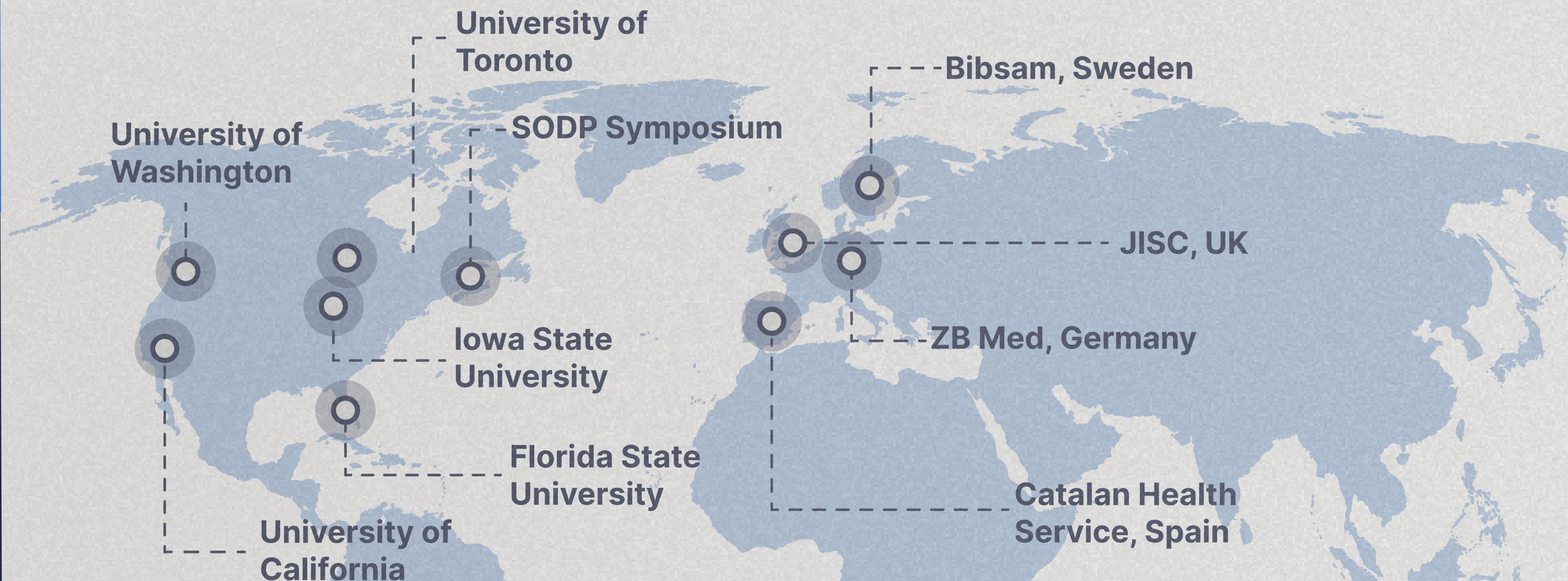
