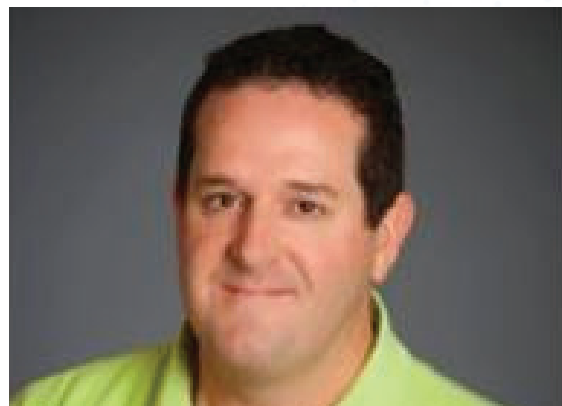

**JMIR Public Health and Surveillance** (JPHS, Editor-in-chief: Travis Sanchez, Rollins School of Public Health, Emory University) is a top-ranked (Q1), peer-reviewed, multidisciplinary journal indexed in Clarivate (SCIE, SSCI), Scopus, PubMed/PMC, and MEDLINE.

JPHS has a unique focus on the intersection of innovation and technology in public health, and includes topics like public health informatics, surveillance (surveillance systems and rapid reports), participatory epidemiology, infodemiology and infoveillance, digital disease detection, digital epidemiology, electronic public health interventions, mass media/social media campaigns, health communication, and emerging population health analysis systems and tools.

In June 2024, JPHS received an impact factor of 3.5. The journal also received a CiteScore of 13.7, placing it in the 97th percentile (#18 of 665) as a Q1 journal in the field of Public Health, Environmental and Occupational Health.

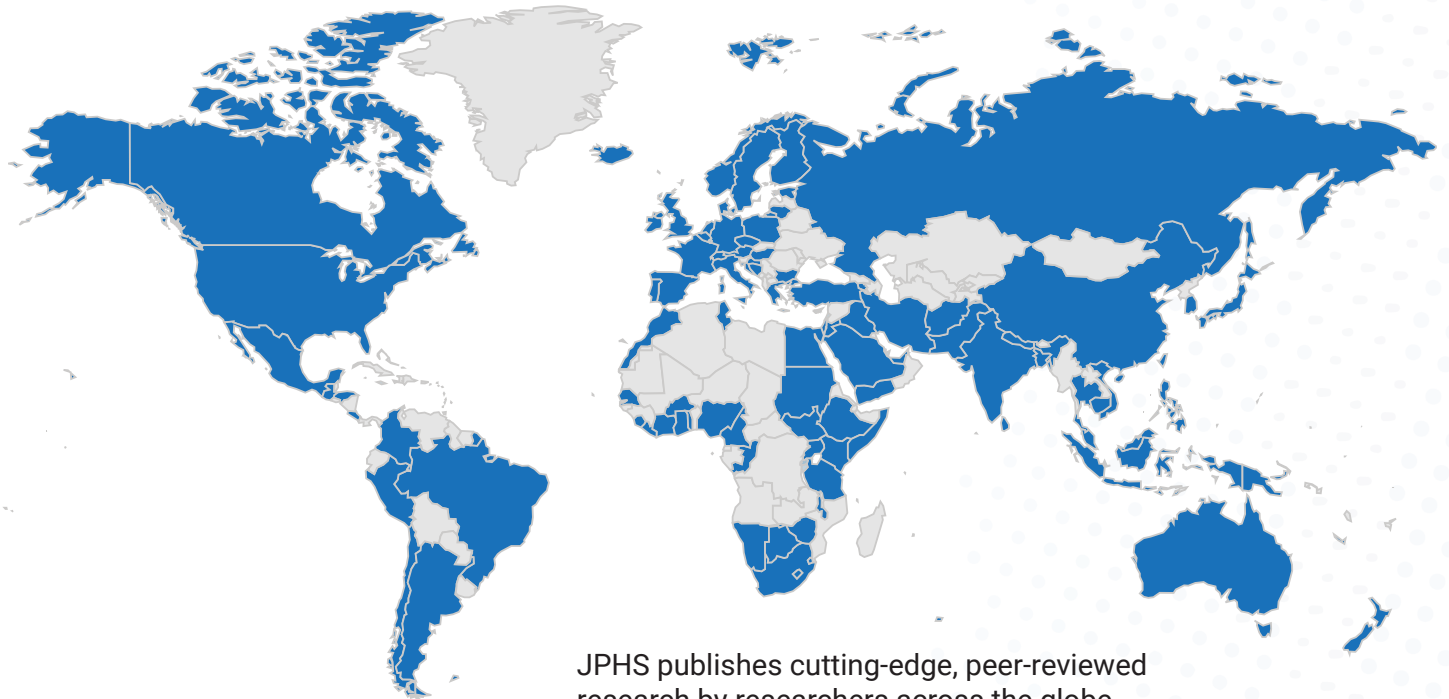
